- ❖ **Derasar is open everyday morning for Angpuja.**
For more information call Sanatbhai/Pramodaben Jhaveri at 973-228-4355
- ❖ **Do only Vasksep puja on Gautamswami and Pundrikswami.**
- ❖ **Do not do Kesar puja on Dev -Devi; instead use Vaskshep tilak on forehead only.**
- ❖ **Ladies can not do Vaskshep tilak on Manibhadravir and Nakoda Bhairavaji.**
- ❖ **There is no need to perform separate Aarti/Mangal Divo for Nageshwar Parshvanath & Shantinath Bhagwans.**
- ❖ **You can simply show Aarti to Nageshwar Parshvanath & Shantinath Bhagwans.**
- ❖ **No one should enter the Gabhara without Puja clothes.**
- ❖ **Do not touch Dev-Devi's murti.**
- ❖ **Use limited amount of water for Abhishek puja.**
- ❖ **A separate kesar-ni Vadki will be placed for each Bhagwan, Please do not bring separate kesar from the kesar room.**
- ❖ **Do not leave fruits and sweets (Naivedya) in the derasar.**
- ❖ **Keep Gabharo, Bhamti and Rangmandap neat and clean.**
- ❖ **No one should bring pratimaji, bhagwan photo, religious books and bulletins without written approval from the EC secretary or Vice President.**
- ❖ **Do not talk or socialize in the derasar.**
- ❖ **No one should consume any food/tea/coffee/or soft drink after Aarti.**
- ❖ **Place your shoes in the rack slot. Do not leave your shoes on the carpet.**

The first pratistha was performed by Gurudev Chitrabhanuji in October 1982 with three gracious pratimaji, Mulnayak Bhagwan Parshvanath, Bhagwan Mahvirswami and Bhagwan Adinath with 600 people and the Caldwell derasar was born in Essex Fells, NJ. It was our community's dream to improve the interior of our derasar.

The renovation project was completed on time and within the approved budget by the construction company under the guidance of our Architect Somchandbhai and Jirnodhar Committee. The Certificate of Occupancy (CO) was received from the township inspectors on Thursday, July 16, 2009 12:39 PM (Vijay Muhurat). With this news, I became a fearless leader because Bhagvan Parshvanath was with me and JCNJ. Thanks Ketanbhai, Ushaben, Dineshbhai, Vinaybhai and Kiritbhai for a great job! Our temple is beautiful with a new marble Ghabharo, Bhanti, and three shikhar, nine Gokhala, Six Pillar and Parapet (Forton materials from Temple Arts). In addition, the rangmandap is graceful with chandelier with state of the art HVAC and audio-video.

A five day Pratistha Mahotsav program was prepared by the various planning committee. A grand procession (Varghodo) was conducted with live band, three buggies and two floats for welcoming Bhagwans and Dev-Devi in the renovated home by more than 750 sangh members. I commend and congratulate the Varghodo and Pratistha teams. The renovated Caldwell Derasar Pratistha was performed with three original Bhagwans plus two new Nageshwar Parshvanath and Shantinath Bhagwans and nine Dev-Devi. The Pratistha Mahotsav was successful and peaceful with tremendous Utasah/Aanad from over 2000 members and dignitaries during two weekends on July 17, 18, 19, 25 and 26, 2009 under guidance from Shri Narendrabhai Nandu. The final Vidhi and pujans were completed with blessings from Gurudev Chitrabhanuji. For the first time live web casting was executed and seen by more than 400 viewers worldwide. **Our Dreams Come True.** Thanks all team members.

The Dwar Opening was done Monday, July 27, 2009 7:30 AM with various pujans. The JCNJ is thankful to all donors and now the temple is open for all. On behalf of the Executive Committee and Board of Trustee, we sincerely thank all volunteers who helped us in this auspicious event. Please accept our Mitchhami Dukaddam if we hurt your feelings.

She has a PhD on Jain Puja Sahitya, Bombay University. She has intensive knowledge of Jain scriptures including Two Pratikraman Sutras along with meaning, Upadhan Tapa, Yogashastra, Yogadrusti Samachchay, Kalpasutra, Tatvarthasutra and many others.

She actively attends and conducts Jain Seminars and Symposia both within and outside India. She has conducted full seminar on National Level at Ritambhara Vishwa Vidyapith, Saputara; Award Trophy winner on National Level in Lecture Competition at Adhyatma Study Circle Bhartiya Vidya Bhavan, Bombay. She has done intense research and written essays on many Jain Philosophies, including "Agam Tantra and Yog with Special reference to Jainism", "Jain Society, its problems and solutions". She has researched on "Life Scratch of Acharya Hemchandra" and many more topics related to Jainism.

For the past five years, she has given public lectures on Jainism, Stress Management, Personality Development, Concentration/Meditation (Dhyan) in day to day life. She was a speaker at JAINA Convention 2009, California. She was the only Jain Scholar in the 18th International Vedic Congress at the University of Massachusetts, Boston and presented a research paper on "Jain Yoga" on July 16-19, 2009. Her mission is: "Spreading of Worlds Best Jain Philosophy and its way of life at all given times and situations".
